A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Harrison County Public Library was held on October 20, 2022. The meeting took place at the Corydon branch of Harrison County Public Library, 105 N. Capitol Avenue, Corydon, IN. Members of the Board of Trustees present: Kathy Crimans, President; Suetta Tingler, Vice President; Barbara Smith, Secretary; Derrick Grigsby, Treasurer; Jon Howerton, Sharon Mathes, and Roger Windell; Alisa Burch, Director, Jessica Stroud, Head of IT/Recording Secretary, Leah Porter of Blue Dot Harrison County, and Brianna Harris, a member of the Leadership Harrison County class of 2023.

Alisa submitted the final report for the ARPA grant. Public Library Services and LSTA Consultant Angela Fox emailed stating, Consider this a successfully completed report on your successfully completed project.

Sonitrol has sent proposals to bring the fire system they installed at Main up to Indiana Code. Jessica is awaiting confirmation from the Harrison County Fire Marshal before proceeding.

The self-check station, paid for with ARPA grant funds, went live Friday, October 14.

Diana Lasky has registered HCPL to participate in the 2023 winter reading program which will run January 1-31. The canned theme is "All the Feels", which we may modify. We hope to once again set a community reading goal with sponsors such as Tyson to donate food for Community Services if the goal is reached. Last year's program was very successful.

Steven Schifcar, with the help of Trevor Smith, was able to use a tall ladder to fix the light in the Palmyra branch foyer, but he was unable to do the exterior lights, the lights in the soffit, or the lights around the flag pole. He has put in a call to Keith Jones Electrical for help.

Trevor Smith, Jessica and Alisa toured the Galena Digital Library and the Makerspace at the Jeffersonville Township Public Library.
